Spring Spanish Classes Beginning

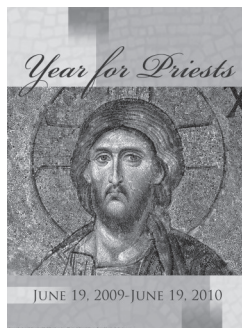
