High Priority Medicines - Greatest Need / De alta prioridad Medicinas Más necesitadas

- Multivitamins for children and adults, esp. chewable vitamins for children
 - Prilosec, omeprazole, Prevacid
 - Axid, Pepcid, Zantac, Tagamet, famotodine, ranitidine, cimetidine
 - Antifungal creams such as clotrimazole, Lotrimin, Tolnaftate, Lamisil
 - Children's chewable acetaminophen (Tylenol) or Junior strength acetaminophen
 - Infant Tylenol or acetaminophen drops
 - Antihistamines such as Benadryl, diphenhydramine, Claritin, loratadine, Zyrtec
 - Antibiotic creams such as Neosporin, Bacitracin, triple antibiotic
 - Hydrocortisone cream
 - Ibuprofen, naproxen (Motrin, Aleve and others)
 - Requesting eyeglasses and reading glasses / *Este ano aceptamos lentes*
 - We would also welcome small items such as splints, slings, shoe inserts, collapsible canes, braces, athletic tapes.

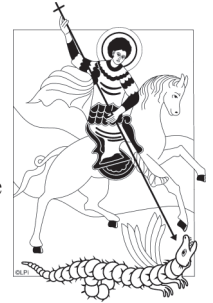
