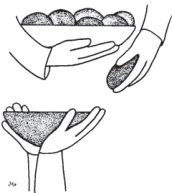

I also want to express that I accompany you every day through prayer, and that prayer unites us in Christ our Lord and sustains the sister parish relationship continuously, in love and communion between our parishes.

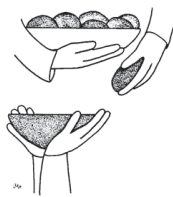
Queridos Hermanos:

## Connecting Faith & Life

### Readings for November 20, the Solemnity of Christ the King

First Reading: Ezekiel 34:11-12, 15-17
