The Lord's Pantry depends on the non-perishable foods we bring in each week and put

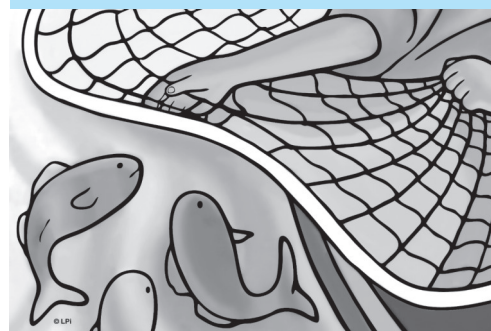

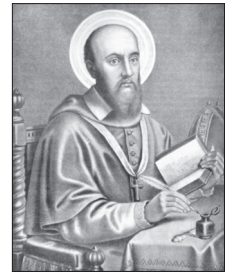
