### Camp Moita Bwawani

Camp Moita Bwawani is underway! We have high school students from all over the parish who are living here. They study various subjects, have religious instruction, and play sports. The days are packed. We begin at 7:30 in the morning and finish at 11 p.m.



We begin the day with morning prayer, then breakfast, then classes until midday.

Then Mass, followed by lunch, and then two hours of sports. The students bathe, meet for evening prayer, eat dinner, then study, and at 9 p.m. we all convene for cultural events, special talks, or just to watch a DVD.

Lights out at 11 p.m.

They play soccer, which they know very well and learn table tennis, volleyball, and basketball on the courts that were just completed this summer.



Seven university students from Ireland are also here. They are with Friends of Africa and raised money back home to support the mission. They, along with five local students, teach subjects such as chemistry, physics, biology, English, and math. We also have



help from five local women who are doing the cooking.

I am the bursar for the camp, do the weekly

shopping in town, and help with some teaching and evening studies.

I also accompanied the students on a trip to Lake Maynara which was the first trip to a national park for most of them and me!



We've had 54 boys for two weeks. They left on Saturday and now 51 girls are here for two weeks. Lots to do!
